Born in Aalborg, Denmark in 1974. Member of BKF & KKS.

Mia primarily works with painting on canvas, mixed media/collage, textiles, and graphics. Mia has participated in several state-recognized juried exhibitions and exhibits in her studio at Art Fairs, galleries, and art associations. Mia exhibits and collaborates with galleries and art centres in Denmark, Spain and Sweden. Mia has conducted school art projects and teaches art/painting at schools and institutions.

full of brightness

Mia has customized courses/workshops privately and in companies since 1999.

Mia's works revolve around freedom, balance, and relationships. They are about encounters between people, what binds us together and what sets us apart, about tying loose ends together and bringing opposites together, and about creating "connectedness."



She often starts with the harmony and contrast of colours. She draws inspiration from texts, books, music, other cultures, art, design, the simple forms of nature, and everyday objects as symbols of interpersonal relationships in everyday spaces and contexts. In the material's structure, volume, surface, and colour lies an inherent identity, which blends in the encounter and forms a new context.

In Mia's recent paintings, she explores organisms in the sea in large canvases/formats inspired by the good news of our time.

They are about hope and all the good that also happens world-wide. Everything around us is full of brightness, positivity, and optimism. It is essential to push away the darkness and away from focusing on misery and fear when there is good news.

Mia finds inspiration in the miraculous recovery of the Great Barrier Reef, the world's largest coral reef.



Connie Boe Boss, an art journalist, says:

"I experience her as a vibrant person, sensitive and observant, and there is indeed something pulsating and vibrating in her paintings, making them very alive and almost sacred to some. She believes everything comes from the same substance and is connected despite different rules, life patterns, and traditions. In general, keywords about Mia are process and play, opposites, order and chaos, form, and colour."



"When I look back on my process in general, it's consciously either very controlled or random. I constantly re-engage myself in my works and always incorporate something from the previous series into the next new starting point. I work in series and simultaneously have many works in progress, preferably in large formats. I create conditions/spaces for myself where things either succeed or fail in a certain way.

This interaction between the controlled and the random is important for the expression I want to achieve in my work. I love the idea of building on ruins. Therefore, my paintings are built up of many layers, where some layers are present throughout, while others are painted over many times. I love working with dogmas.

It can be the rule of exclusively using a certain number of shapes, patterns, spaces, or colours or sweeping the floor for the last clippings and only using them for the next collages. I love working in contrasts in colours, shapes, and different materials. I paint loosely and with tempo. I allow things to emerge in the process. I rarely have more than a loose sketch before I start, and my approach and working process are playful and experimental."

The pots have inspired me in various directions, motivating me to paint them and create new artwork on their surfaces.

The pots come in varying sizes and shapes. All of them are double-coated to deepen the colour and create shine.

Each pot represents a unique story with components from my artistic language.


